Results

Only 5 participants (1 male and 4 females) took part in this study. Each participant was paid £5 for taking part.

Due to the extremely low N and the difficulty in recruiting/running additional participants this study was halted.

All data was recorded on computer and would have been examined at the conclusion of the study. However, given the low N no analyses were conducted due to insufficient data and no data for individual participants (other than N and gender) were known when the study was halted, or have been examined since then. As such, no results are reported for the 5 participants who took part.
